UNHACKABLE INZERO EXPANDS FEDERAL REACH

WASHINGTON, DC – InZero, the Virginia high-tech research firm that developed the special hardware-based technology to protect computer networks from cyber attacks, announced the formation of a new unit, InZero Federal Services, to focus on increased demand for the product from federal agencies.

“The demand for the product has been overwhelming,” said CEO Lou Hughes. “We have been receiving literally hundreds of requests a week.”

The federal services unit is the “logical next step in the evolution and marketing of this unique and very important product to defend our government and major corporations against cyber attacks,” Hughes said. “As Business Week and Bloomberg recently reported, InZero ‘closes the gate on cyber crime.’ It is simply unhackable.”

A demonstration of how InZero successfully protects computers against literally billions of cyber attacks from multiple sources will be conducted at the National Press Club June 24 for members of Congress and federal security officials.

General Wesley Clark, Chairman of InZero’s Advisory Board, said the technology is vital for the nation’s security and for protection of critical infrastructure. “This technology is essentially what the Administration and Congress have been calling for,” he said. “It has now been thoroughly tested, it is affordable, it is available, and in addition to providing a new high level of security for computers, its use could save taxpayers billions of dollars.”
